COMPLAINT – PIPER ALDERMAN

I refer to previous correspondence.

I note that I have now considered all the material that you have previously provided to the Board.

Firstly, I advise that the report of Cosoff Cudmore & Knox to the Legal Practitioners Conduct Board is a document to which legal professional privilege attaches. Cosoff Cudmore & Knox were the legal advisers to the Board in relation to this complaint and as such their report cannot be released to you.

I note that Mr Abbott is no longer the Presiding Member of the Legal Practitioners Conduct Board and has not been the Presiding Member since 20 September 2011. Cosoff Cudmore & Knox were engaged by the Board at a time when Mr Abbott was the Presiding Member of the Board in order that there be no perception of a conflict of interest.

You have raised in your email of 4 June 2012 a suggestion that the Board arrange conciliation in relation to costs subject to the adjudication in the Supreme Court. The Board can conciliate in matters where both parties consent to that course of action. I have contacted Piper Alderman requesting that they advise whether they would be prepared to attend a conciliation.

In the event that the parties agree to conciliate I enquire as to whether you are prepared to attend a conciliation to be held in Adelaide sometime in July 2012. Your earliest advice in relation to this matter would be appreciated.
